Today, we celebrate the **4th Sunday of Lent** which is also **Mothering Sunday.** And we are celebrating it differently to how we would normally celebrate - with the joy and exuberance of our Sunday School. Our Archbishops have asked us to make today a day of prayer for the world and I would encourage you to spend as much time to day as you can in prayer.

We use the term 'lock down' but in other times the word 'quarantine' would have been used. The latter word is often associated with periods of self-isolation to avoid contagion & the spread of disease. The word has its origins in the Italian word for 40 days. It also reminds us of the 40 days & nights of the of Lent, when we remember the time Jesus spent in the wilderness.

These are extraordinary times. Earlier this week, following the advice of our Archbishops and Bishops, public worship ceased at St Paul's, Bow Common until further notice. For the time being the building is open for private prayer Monday-Saturday 8am-5.30pm and Sundays from 11.00am-5.30pm.

And so, since we can no longer gather together, we are using our creativity to find ways of worshipping together – using technology.

I will pray morning prayer and evening in church Monday-Saturday at 8am & 5.30pm. You may join virtually using Zoom.

I will pray a virtual Service of **Spiritual Communion on Sundays at 11am** so do Zoom in. **At 7pm on Sundays I invite everyone of us to light a candle as we pray 'A Blessing of the Light' Service.** I will pray it in church and you can join in virtually. It will be a comfort to us all to know that each of us has gathered together in our home and are praying at the same time

The self-isolation and physical distancing that is needed of each of us to stem the spread of the Coronavirus will require us to draw considerably from the strength of our God.

In the early church, the desert fathers and mothers withdrew from ordinary society and sought the solitude of the desert, imitating Jesus in the wilderness. In doing so, they learned to devote their lives in prayer and to structure their day in such a way as to cultivate the virtues of love, compassion and self-discipline. In doing this they learned something of the vulnerability of being human.

We will need to continue to support each other in the days, weeks and months ahead, to pray with each other (virtually) and for each other. We must also ensure that the most vulnerable receive the support they need. So I encourage you to continue to spend time in prayer. I've uploaded resources to our Whatsapp Group, that you may use either virtually or privately.

Finally, I encourage you again to draw on God and on each other for support. We are the Body of Christ here and as such we have the Good News of Christ to sustain us and support us and our neighbour. If you become unwell and need help, then let me know.
