

Today we celebrate **Trinity Sunday** - focusing on the uniquely profound and mysterious revelation of God, the Holy Trinity – three distinct Persons inseparably bound in love as one God. Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

## June 14<sup>th</sup> is the third anniversary of the Grenfell Tower

fire. This year the community in North Kensington is understandably finding it difficult to mark the anniversary in the usual way. Members of the local community including Grenfell United, the bereaved and survivors and have come up with a way in which we as the Church across London might be able to help mark this important occasion, and express our sympathy and support for those still affected by the tragedy. On previous anniversaries, the bell in the local parish church has rung 72 times, once for each victim of the fire. The new idea this year is that at 6pm on Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> June, bells in churches all across London would ring 72 times. This would initiate two minutes silence, after which there would be three more rings, one for each year since the fire itself. In this way, in the absence of public events, people across London might be reminded of the anniversary and those who still live with the memory of the fire would feel that this important moment for them is marked in a properly public way. An online vigil will begin at that point for those who wish to access it.

So I will be ringing the bell of our church to mark this occasion. I will Zoom the ringing and you are welcome to join me on Zoom.
