

PCC Highlights (November 2020 meeting):

New Members: The PCC welcomed Cara, Edward and Boikanyo as new PCC members and introduced them to the workings and ways of the PCC.

Matters Arising:

<u>Open House:</u> PCC thanked Hendrika and Ruth for all their work in ensuring that we were able receive visitors safely. Despite the pandemic there were a good number of visitors.

<u>Parking:</u> Long term parking has been offered to a number of local businesses.

<u>Hall Use:</u> Blue Skies & CA expressed their wish to return to the premises as soon as it was safe to do so. This will involve additional cleaning to ensure the building maintains covid secure hygiene standards.

Spires Business Plan Presentation: The church received HLF funding to engage a company (Spires) to help us develop a business plan for future funding applications. The team came along to the PCC to set our their experience of working on business plans, community audits, etc. The purpose of the business blan would be to grow the church, attact funding and secure the future of the church. Local consultations and market research are already taking place and it is anticipated the work will be finished by Christmas with a final document in January 2021. It was agreed at the meeting that Spires would attend a Sunday Service as part of their research and engagement.

Safeguarding: No safeguarding issues had been reported and it was noted that due to the pandemic Sunday School is not currently running.

Repairs to West & Porch Doors: It was reported that funding had been secured from two HFL pots to repair the West and Porch Doors. This work will be finished by the end of January 2021.

Finance: Our income has dramatically reduced and it was reported that we may have to draw on our reserves where receipt of funds and invoices for repair work did not coincide. PCC discussed how the congregation could be kept informed of the financial position of the church and it was agreed that shorts talks could be given at suitable points.

Advent & Christmas Season of Giving: PCC agreed to launch a giving campaign to fundraise in the spirit of the 'giving' engendered by the Christmas Bazaar. Events such as Christmas Quiz, Raffle, donations would be promoted to the congregation and friends of St Pauls.
